- As part of our own commitment and objectives we have declared that we will only deal with vendors who take a similar view of environmental stewardship.

How do we know who shares this view?

- Firstly we ask all vendors about their policy and commitment to the environment and how that translates into actions.

How do we know who's walking the talk?

- We ask vendors to prove that their policy statements are not hollow rhetoric by having the implementation of their policies, systems/procedures audited by a qualified independent person.

How do we know the standard reached and that vendors are improving?

- We require that the yard stick used to measure Environmental management systems, by the independent auditor, is an internationally recognized standard which has been adopted as a national standard of Canada by the Standards Council of Canada. ISO 14001:2004 is that standard.
